The Louisiana State Board of Dentistry requires that dentists with adult sedation permits take 10 hours in the two-year term. Additionally, the LSBP requires that dentists with pediatric permits for pediatric patients will have 10 of six hours of pediatric sedation renewal AND 6 hours of the adult sedation renewal every two years. In the permit holder has a pediatric certification and obtainS crNA pediatric status the age of 12, and they are certified to treat adults, then only the 6 hour in-person pediatric sedation course is necessary.

Course Description

This course reviews a review and updates of moderate sedation for pediatric patients. It is intended to provide dentists with the basic knowledge and core competencies that promote safe and effective dental sedation in children. This course focuses on patient selection risk assessment and prevention of tooth extraction. In pediatric dentistry, addition monitor, medication, and drug management, and the recognition and management of medication and anesthetic-related complications.

The Louisiana State Board of Dental Treatment requires that dentists with sedation permits for pediatric patients attend a live, 6-hour course every two years. This course meets the requirements for renewal of a moderate sedation permit for pediatric patients in Louisiana.

Course Objectives

- After participating in this course, participants will be better able to:
- Assess the suitability of moderate sedation for the delivery of dental care for pediatric patients
- Differentiate pediatric anatomy and physiology in contrast to an adult patient
- Apply lifestyle behavior guidance for the pediatric dental patient to ensure high standards of moderate sedation success
- Utilize semi-enhanced sedatives and transition medications used in pediatric behavior and airway management
- Assess the scope of moderate sedation for children with special needs (e.g., 1-on-20 non-ASA patients)
- Understand the role and emotional nitrous oxide in sedating pediatric dental patients
- Understand the role and safety limits of local anesthetics when used for pediatric dental sedations
- Manage sedative-related emergencies that can occur in pediatric patients
